For three years, Dr. Miller coordinated the Victim Assistance Academy while completing her doctoral program in Criminal Justice at UALR. This experience gave her additional insights into the experiences of victims, and the work of victim advocates in supporting them. Adding this additional lens enhanced her depth of understanding of offenders as well, many of whom have their own mental health issues and who often times had their own victimization prior to offending. This workshop will discuss lessons learned from coordinating the academy, the overlap within criminal justice issues, look at victimization within our systems, and the impact of crime on victims, offenders, and society at large. A panel will end the presentation by facilitating a discussion about the content and how increasing our knowledge of this system can assist in our support of the victims we serve.
