Overview of Trauma-Informed Care in Behavioral Health

This three-hour training provides information to build a trauma-informed care workforce by assisting human service professionals in understanding the impact and consequences of trauma on functioning. The workshop will also include information about assessment and treatment strategies in current use that support recovery.
